# **Rank Order Activity**

Rank the following 5 attributes of classroom discussion from most to least important. Make some short notes to explain your thinking.

### **Everyone Participates**

All students participate actively in the discussion (this can include active listening).

## **Diversity of Opinions**

Multiple viewpoints on a given issue are expressed and defended.

## **Appropriate Use of Evidence**

Students support their opinions with evidence that is relevant and accurate.

#### Minimal Teacher Involvement

Students lead and direct the vast majority of the discussion, and the instructor only intervenes to facilitate or mediate when necessary.

## **Respectful Environment**

Students follow the rules of classroom etiquette and treat each other with respect.

#### Instructions

- 1. Rank discussion attributes from most important (1) to least important (5). Jot down some notes if needed. (4 minutes)
- 2. Divide the table into two groups of four.
- 3. Assign a timekeeper (person who has been a teacher the longest).
- 4. Take turns sharing order and reasoning. Person with the most recent birthday goes first. (2 minutes each 8 min total)
- 5. Discuss and compare What differences do you notice? What accounts for these differences? Does anyone want to change the order they started with? (3 minutes)
